### 50 Years Ago in Club History

The Optimist Club of St. Charles was the vision of a small group of individuals who met in the lower level of Pio's Restaurant. Bob Gebbons from the Brentwood Optimist Club and Richard Green from St. Charles sent out notices to local businesses encouraging the owners or someone from their companies to join this new service club. As interest increased, these early participants were encouraged to invite other prospective members, though most of the recruiting was done by Bob and Richard. The club was formally established with 45 members on April 27, 1971. The club's first community service project was Respect for Law and the first fund-raising event was the Spaghetti Dinner. Richard Green was the charter President and Ed Kruse (Sharon North's father) was the charter Secretary/Treasurer. ### St. Charles Proposition SCSD





Club members Jason Sefrit, Superintendent of the St. Charles School District, and Andrew Stewart, Director of Lewis & Clark and a leader of the Proposition SCSD Informational Team, provided information on this no tax increase bond issue that allows the District to borrow money to fund capital projects such as building renovations, repairs, technology costs and other building upgrades. If approved, Proposition SCSD will generate approximately \$50M for the District without raising the District's debt service tax rate. The proposition is on the April 6<sup>th</sup> ballot. # OPTIMIST CLUB OF ST. CHARLES BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES March 16, 2021

CALL TO ORDER: President Fred McGinley called the meeting to order at 1:04 pm.

ATTENDANCE: Bob Beckman, Dave Borgmeyer, Mark Cook, Allen Field, Fred McGinley, Ellen Parker, Gerry Prinster, Jack Ross, and Dale Westby. Also in attendance was Roger Deppe.

### **SECRETARY REPORT:**

Dale Westby moved to approve the minutes of February 23, 2021. Mark Cook seconded.
 The minutes were approved.

### TREASURER REPORT: Treasurer Dave Borgmeyer reported that:

- The annual dues for Sam's Club went up about \$20 to \$140.
- Scholarship funds are fine.
- \$2000 has been transferred from savings to checking to cover the regular expenses and budgeted items.
- Most budgeted items for the year have already been paid except for the donations to local schools for their drug-free grad nights.
- CD matures in July of 2021. At that time he will withdraw \$7,000 and put it in savings to cover expenses as needed since we haven't been able to hold our usual fundraisers.
- As of February 28, 2021, the general checking account had a balance of \$1,490.36. The savings account had a balance of \$3,071.31. The CDs total \$37,316.77. General Accounts total was \$41,878.44. The Scholarship Fund balance was \$185,933.53. The dues account showed a balance of \$1,636.23.
- Bob Beckman moved to file the February financial report with the auditor. Allen Field seconded. Motion passed.

- <u>Essay and Oratorical Contests</u>: Chairman Bob Beckman reported that essay winners will be recognized on Zoom at the noon meeting on April 13, 2021. The top two winners of the oratorical contest will compete at the regional level competition on Zoom on April 17.
- Golf Tournament: Chairman Fred McGinley reported that flyers and posters for this year's tournament on June 7 are being printed. Members should start spreading the word and getting teams together. We hope to match or surpass last year's total of 73 golfers. He also reported that he is looking into a computer program that will make registration accessible by credit card.
- <u>50 Year Anniversary/Installation Banquet</u>: Chairman Dale Westby reported that plans are still in the working stages. Nothing new to report.
- Scholarship Committee: Entries are still coming in.
- <u>Fishing Derby</u>: Chairman Mark Cook reported that we will probably not be able to hold the event this year.
- <u>Election Committee</u>: Discussion centered around potential candidates. The committee will meet after the board meeting.

  - OI Updated Guidelines for In-Person Meetings: The following guidelines were presented by Secretary Ellen Parker: Optimist International provides the following guidance for Club and District Meetings occurring through June 28, 2021.

    - Regardless of local regulations, Optimist International requires masks be worn at all times, except while actively eating or drinking.
