OPTIMIST CLUB OF ST. CHARLES BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES April 20, 2021

CALL TO ORDER: President-Elect Bob Beckman called the meeting to order at 12:59 pm.

ATTENDANCE: Bob Beckman, Dave Borgmeyer, Mark Cook, Mike Ebert, Allen Field, Steve Harker, Mary Krogmeier, Ellen Parker, Gerry Prinster, Dale Westby. Also in attendance was Roger Deppe.

SECRETARY REPORT:

 Dale Westby moved to approve the minutes of April 20, 2021. Mark Cook seconded. The minutes were approved.

TREASURER REPORT: Treasurer Dave Borgmeyer reported that:

- Main income from April was from paid lunches.
- Main expenses from April include the annual Boy Scout donation of \$200 and the donation for the Jefferson Love Awards of \$2500.
- The scholarship awards for this year amounted to \$5500. Five \$1000 scholarships and one \$500 community college scholarship. \$5000 was taken from the scholarship fund and \$500 from the general account.
- The CD's mature at the end of next month, Dave Borgmeyer will withdraw \$7000 and transfer it to our savings account. He will roll over the remaining amount.
- As of April 30, 2021, the general checking account had a balance of \$1,882.01. The savings account had a balance of \$571.44. The CD's total \$37,399.50. General Accounts total was \$39,852.95. The Scholarship Fund balance was \$187,110.52. The dues account showed a balance of \$947.17.
- Steve Harker moved to file the April financial report with the auditor. Allen Field seconded. Motion passed.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- Golf Tournament: We currently have 15 teams signed up (5 paid), 16 hole sponsors (10 paid), and 1 lunch sponsor (paid). Treasurer Dave Borgmeyer stated that more checks are coming in.
- <u>50 Year Anniversary/Installation Banquet</u>: Chairman Dale Westby has sent an email to charter members. Possible ideas include a proclamation from the city and/or county, inviting the mayor and our regional Optimist leaders, and Steve Harker's video. Chairman Westby also requested that members pass on any additional ideas for the banquet. Ellen Parker will send out an invitation flyer to each member when she sends out the invoices at the beginning of August.
- Scholarship Committee: Chairman Mike Ebert reported that we awarded \$1000 scholarships to five seniors attending a four-year university and one \$500 scholarship to a senior attending community college.
- <u>Project Invite</u>: Roger Deppe submitted his outcomes report (attached at end of minutes). The Omega team earned 45 points. The Alpha team earned thirty points. Thank you Roger for your work on this project and your attempts to improve our club.
- Respect for Law: Chairman Jack Ross sent a message that everything is set to honor recipients from the St. Charles City Police and County Police at next week's meeting, May 25th.
